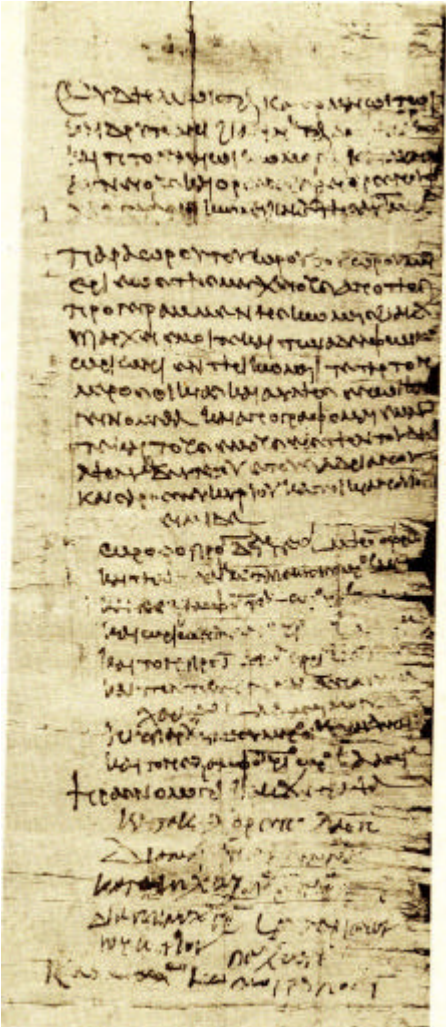

Thanks to scholars who revealed numerous archaeological discoveries and began to decipher the Dead Sea Scrolls we now have a clear picture of the world of the Middle East at the turn of the first Millennium. As historical evidence has become available, we have acquired copies of Caesar's census on papyrus, a copy of Pontius Pilate's cornerstone from Caesarea,

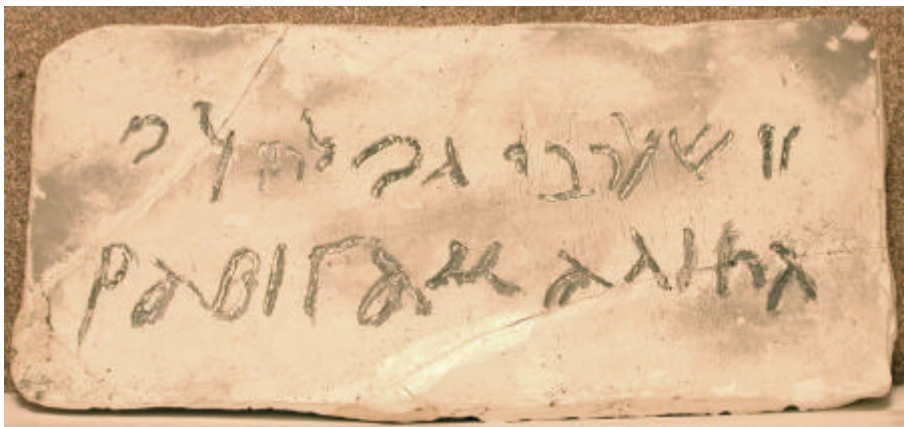


**Pontius Pilate Cornerstone**

and the ossuary of High Priest Caiaphas, the first evidence of crucifixion in the first century. In addition, there is documentation of the recently found Jesus Boat, Peter's House, and the Synagogue in Capernaum, as well as the inscription on the ossuary of Gamaliel, teacher of Apostle Paul.
